'inputtrc.sty' produces screen/log messages
'<current> INPUTTING <next>' on LaTeX input commands,
<current> and <next> being file names.
The message indents reflect the input nesting level.
This can be turned on and off, and the "indent unit"
can be chosen. 'RETURNING TO <current>' may be added.
These messages should help when you otherwise get a screen
message about some input line number and wonder in which
file that is.

The implementation somewhat resembles packages 'currfile',
'filehook', 'FiNK', and 'inputfile'.
